Extreme weather resistance

IKO roof shingles are highly resistant to any type of weather, ranging from polar temperatures through to tropical heat, moisture and wind. The fiberglass base is very stable, the exterior is extremely durable and the covering granules provide the ultimate form of protection.

Therefore IKO can provide real protection on your roof against hailstorms, gale force winds of up to 220 km/hour, snow and ice, desert heat and UV rays.

Budget friendly

Having a light roof structure makes a great difference in the overall construction of your home. When compared to conventional roofing materials, shingles are much lighter in weight and more flexible, without compromising quality levels at all. A reduced weight on a roof allows you to build more efficient, and not to spend more on thick walls and concrete slab to support a higher roof load.

IKO roof shingles are **very quick and efficient to install**, as their light weight simply adds to the superior quality and they can simply be placed over the existing roof construction with renovation projects.

Noticeably stylish

IKO roof shingles are available in a great variety of colours and shapes that fit in with every type of building style and environment. To cover any difficult shape of the roof with bitumen roof shingles is very easy. You don't need any special tools as saw, special benders or accessories, you need only a cutting knife and a hammer. Through the difficult roof details you will go 3-4 times faster.

Because of the **colour stable and UV resistant** qualities of the product, it maintains its original aesthetic appearance for a very long period of time and easily fits onto any shape of roof from 9,5° to 90° roof slope. With such flexibility and choice, there are all kinds of creative possibilities waiting to be discovered. IKO has even a solution for concrete roof decks and **for very low sloped roof** as from 4° or roof parts, like dormer or low slope overhang roof (Check out IKO Shingles Thermo system).







4. Eco friendly

The light weight of shingles also provides a positive ecological effect. The transport weight of **the material is light** resulting in a much smaller impact on the environment. Also, the various ventilation systems in the IKO range enable **optimum air circulation**, which is good for your health and result in lower energy bills.

Building an energy efficient house, with a well ventilated shingle roof will increase the living comfort and improve the efficiency of your investment by having lower energy bills to cool your living space during the warm season or to heat it during the cold season.









5. Perfect insulation

IKO roof shingles absorb a great amount of noise caused by rain and hail on a roof, making our product the superior option for noise insulation when compared to other materials.

It is also much harder for vermin to penetrate shingle roofs, providing additional protection for your attic.

Fire resistance and not(!) dangerous

It is a complete misconception that shingles are dangerous waste and are likely to catch fire.

IKO Shingles are made from fiberglass, impregnated with bitumen (waste product from oil industry) and on top the shingle is finished with natural stone granules and on the backside with sand.

IKO Shingles do not contain asbestos or tar constituents, and are free from any other dangerous substances. When removing old shingles from your house, they do not belong in any "special" waste container, but can be recycled, just like fiberglass.

Catching water to be used for gardening purposes is another advantage of IKO shingles: our products are **certified** according to the Dutch building decree!

IKO is complying fully with the strict fire certificates BRoofT1 and BRoof3 (Cambridge Xtreme and Armourglass PLUS). IKO Shingles in contact with fire is not fueling the fire, but act as a fire reducer. They are as fire resistant as any other roofing material.
